## **Röko makes its first investment – Arboritec**

The newly started investment company Röko AB ("Röko") has agreed to, through a holding company, acquire 80% of the shares of Arboritec AB and Arboritec USA Inc. Both companies are indirectly owned by the founder Jörgen Kaldemark, who will remain as a 20% minority shareholder.

Arboritec was founded in 1999 and is based in Jörlanda north of Gothenburg. The company manufactures and markets waterbased finishes for wooden flooring. It had a turnover exceeding 30 MSEK last year, it is growing and has good profitability.

"We found Arboritec to be a healthy, international company with great products. But it is small. We hope to help the company grow its business with continued good profitability." says Tomas Billing, Chairman of Röko

"I am very satisfied that Arboritec is the first investment of Röko. We can grow the company together. I also think Röko has an interesting future and has decided to invest in Röko." says Jörgen Kaldemark, Founder and Owner of Arboritec
