Röko acquires a majority of Brownell

Röko has agreed to acquire a majority of the shares of MCCN Holdings, the holding company for Brownell Limited (Brownell), a leading developer of moisture control and humidity protection products. Brownell is based in London in the UK and supplies a wide variety of products e.g., desiccators, humidity indicators, pressure relief valves to more than 30 countries around the world. Brownell employs 40 people and had revenues of 9 MGBP in 2021.

Brownell was established in 1952 and subsequently taken over by current CEO Neil Partridge's father in a management buyout in 2002. Neil, who's been CEO since 2018, will remain in his position as CEO and as a minority shareholder going forward. The investment is Röko's 18th since the company was founded.
